PROFESSOR RICKARD BRANEMARK

Professor of Orthopaedics Founder of Integrum AB, Sweden Professor Branemark is internationally acclaimed as the most experienced surgeon in osseointegration, having developed the OPRA™ Implant System and founded Integrum in Gothenberg, Sweden in 1998. He has pioneered studies in titanium bone anchored prostheses with more than 20 years of experience and awarded the Hanger Prize in 2007 for his contribution to amputation research.



PAUL CULPAN

Consultant Complex Lower Limb Trauma & Orthopaedic Surgeon Mr Culpan specialises in the management of complex lower limb trauma patients at the largest trauma centre in Europe, the Royal London Hospital. He is one of a handful of surgeons performing 3D reconstructive surgery and has pioneered orthopaedic implants in the field of complex trauma surgery, including the only complete pelvic and acetabular specific plating system in the world.



PETER BATES

Consultant Orthopaedic and Poly Trauma Surgeon and Medico-legal Expert Mr Bates is clinical director of orthopaedics at the largest trauma centre in Europe and is an honorary senior lecturer in orthopaedic trauma sciences at Queen Mary's University of London. Recognised as a global expert in major and complex poly trauma, he has engineered pioneering orthopaedic implants in the field of trauma surgery. He also works as a medico-legal expert specialising in cases involving high energy injury.



PARVIZ SADIGH

Consultant Plastic Reconstructive Surgeon Mr Sadigh is an accomplished plastic reconstructive surgeon specialising in post trauma reconstruction at the Royal London Hospital. He is also an honorary senior lecturer in microsurgery at Queen Mary's University of London. He sub-specialises in complex microsurgical reconstruction of the extremities in trauma and is one of a few surgeons in the UK who can operate in this subspecialty.
